OUR MISSION

The Rose Villa Foundation supports independence, advances well-being, empowers residents, and inspires our community to build a better future for all generations.

WHAT WE DO

Through our Four Pillars, the Foundation provides critical financial assistance for housing and support of residents who outlive their resources. We offer educational programs, workshops, and services to enrich the lives of all Rose Villa residents, their family members and the community. The Foundation is a 501c3 nonprofit that works in close collaboration with Rose Villa Inc. to assist with the financial needs and well-being of residents.

THE FOUNDATION'S FOUR PILLARS

Resident Assistance

Core to the mission and fundraising work of the Foundation since 1963, this pillar provides financial assistance for housing and care to residents who have depleted their financial resources. Donations to this pillar provide a safety net that ensures that residents who have lived at Rose Villa for seven years will have resources necessary to continue to live at Rose Villa while maintaining their dignity and independence.

Education And Enrichment

Knowing that we never stop learning, this pillar helps promote the financial, physical, mental, and social well-being of residents, family and the community through cutting-edge workshops and innovative speakers series.

Professional Services Support

This pillar provides support in the form of confidential one-on-one financial coaching and access to a vetted list of professional financial planners, fiduciaries, legal counselors, and tax service providers.

Donations to this pillar allows the Board of Directors to determine how best to use your gift and leverage operational funds for specific improvements or programs that enhance the well-being of residents at Rose Villa.



OUR LEADERSHIP

The Foundation is led by an Executive Director and governed by a volunteer Board of Directors comprised of residents, Rose Villa Inc. Board members, and community members. The Foundation Board oversees the Foundation's investments, monitors resources and programs, sets financial assistance criteria, and reviews policies and procedures. This dedicated group personally supports the Foundation and its members serve as ambassadors by educating residents, families and the community about the work of the Foundation and opportunities to donate.

INVEST IN A CHARITABLE GIFT ANNUITY

Available to Rose Villa Residents, a Charitable Gift Annuity allows you to do two things: purchase an annuity for life and make a gift to the Foundation. This is a simple contract between you (any resident 70 and older) and the Rose Villa Foundation where you transfer assets (a \$12,000 minimum) to the Foundation and in return, the Foundation guarantees a fixed payment for the rest of your life. 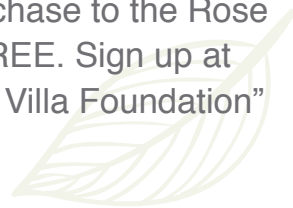
